### MISSION & MINISTRY OPPORTUNITIES

Now that we're our "own" district, are you feeling a little lost – wondering how to continue with our various missions?

Mission and Ministry Opportunities will be an ongoing feature in WOW newsletters. The ministry of GLOBAL HEALTH MINISTRIES will featured in this first newsletter.

# GLOBAL HEALTH MINISTRIES (GHM)

The Fridley, Minnesota based ministry's mission is: Global Health Ministries continues the healing ministry of Jesus Christ by enhancing health care programs of Lutheran churches in other countries. GHM is providing health care projects in Bangladesh, Cameroon, Liberia, Madagascar, Nigeria, Papua New Guinea, Tanzania and Central African Republic.

GHM is supported by several Lutheran denominations, World Mission Prayer League, and Partners in Mission. They were recently awarded their 8th consecutive year of 4-stars (out of a possible 4) rating of how they provided services to overseas churches and for their low administrative costs.

## PROJECT DIRECTIONS FOR NEWBORN KITS

Please use new or gently used clean items.

- 36" square muslin or sheeting not necessary to hem
- regular size bath towel no longer than 48"
- wash cloth
- bath size bar of white Ivory soap
- newborn stocking cap (see directions below) This may be sewn, knit or crocheted.
- small baby shirt, size 0-3 months or newborn
- 1 receiving blanket

Please donate \$5 per kit. Do not include the money with the kit. Pack each kit in a 2-2 1/2 gal. Ziploc plastic bag. Squeeze air out of the bag before sealing.

Finished Newborn Kits will be collected at the October Annual Meeting.

### **HELPFUL HINTS**

**Infant Stocking Cap**: Cut an 8"X8" piece of stretchy knit fabric (like a tee shirt), fold in half lengthwise and sew or serge the edge. Gather the top and sew or tie. Fold up the other end. Newborn's head is about 14". Knitted and Crocheted cap directions are on the next sheet.

**Receiving blankets**: approximate size is 30"X 30". Serge or finish edge with a close zig zag.

# KNITTED BABY CAP

- Use baby yarn or thin soft 3 ply and needles to match yarn
- Cast on 68 stitches on 2 needles VERY LOOSELY
- Rib: 2 knit, 2 pearl for 12 rows
- Continue in stocking stitch until 3.5"
- Decrease gradually for 1 "
- Total length of cap 4.5 inches
- Pull yarn through remaining stitches, gather and fasten
- Sew seam

# CROCHETED BABY CAP

Ch = chain st = stitch sc = single crochet Slp st = slip stitch dc = double crochet

Suggested yarn: Bernat's Softee Baby; Red Heart Baby Soft, Lion Brand Twinkle Hook Size: G or smaller or larger, depending on how tightly you crochet

6 double crochets equal 1 inch

Cap length approximately 51/2 ", excluding Row 19

Row 1: ch 4, slp st in starting ch, ch 3(counts as first dc), 9 dc in circle, join with slp st into beginning chain 3. 10 dc

Row 2: ch 1, turn; 2 sc in first dc and in each dc around. Join with slp st to first sc. 20 sc

**Row 3**: ch 3(counts as first dc, now and throughout), turn; dc in next 3 sc, 2 dc in next sc; dc in next 4 sc, 2 dc in next sc; repeat from \* around; join with slp st to first dc. 24 dc

**Row 4**: ch 1, turn; sc in first dc, sc in next dc, \*2 sc in next dc, sc in next dc, repeat from \* around, join with slip st to first sc. 36 sc

**Row 5**: ch 3, turn; dc in first sc and in each sc around, join with slp st to first dc.

**Row 6**: ch 1, turn; sc in first dc, sc in next dc, \*2 sc in next dc, sc in next dc, repeat from \* around, join with slp st to first sc. 54 sc. This is your last increase.

Row 7: ch 3, turn; dc in first sc and in each sc around; join with slp st to first dc.

Row 8: ch 1, turn; sc in first dc and in each dc around; join with slp st to first sc

**Row 9 thru 18**: Repeat Row 7 and 8 for pattern, keeping each round at 54 stitches

**Optional Edging: Row 19**: (shell stitch), ch 1, sc cr in same space, \*skip 2 sc, 5 dc in next sc, skip 2 sc, sc in next sc. Repeat from \*, ending with sc in last sc, slp stitch to beginning sc, cut thread and fasten. (9 shells total).
