-Isaiah 9:2



# From The Board of World Missions

The AD Board of World Missions met in January with the following results: \$12,800 was sent to our partner congregation in Tabor, Ethiopia, \$5,345 was sent for North Central Ethiopia Synod (NCES), and \$1,500 for pastors in northern India with All India Masihi Jamat (AIMJ). The board decided to pledge \$45,000 this year to Tabor for their evangelist's salaries (this represents 30% or less of the salaries paid), plus we'd like to raise funds to help meet another need. This may include construction costs or bicycles or motorbikes. Stay tuned for more info.

## **Mission Minute**

'I am Parthibi Begum. I come from an orthodox Muslim family. I have my mother Sufia Begum and father Seikh Karimul Hoque. He works as a farmer and has a small piece of land inherited by my grandfather. Because we have a small land, the overall income was less but we managed to eat two meals a day. I wanted to



help him to generate for income and decided to work with him on the farm. He denied me to work on the farm as he didn't want me to work day and night like him.

Few days later, I came to know that free tailoring classes are given to the women in the village for generating income by The Muneer Social Welfare Society. I decided to enroll my name for the classes. It was one-year training program and all those who would complete the training will get Diploma Certificates too. On the first day of our class, Muneer Community Workers told us about their goal '*Smile on every face*'. After hearing this, I thought that this is the right place for me. But right before giving the training our teacher prayed to Jesus. Hearing the prayer, I came to know that they

were Christians. But I never told this to my parents as they would not let me continue this training. For the sake of earning money, I ignored the fact that this place was run by Christians.



Every day, they would teach us lessons from Bible and tell us stories of Jesus. This happened while we were in the class. They never took extra time to teach these things. Eventually, I began to like these stories, teachings and looked forward to learning more the next day. The stories were told by Bro. Abdul Rashid. Even though he was not our teacher, he looked after the center and all the students. I also began to enjoy their prayers as they always prayed for us and our families. I also began to tell the stories and teachings to my parents but never told them that these were from Bible. They too liked listening to the stories and teachings. After I got my diploma Bro. Abdul Rashid also gave me literatures and told me that he knows that I like what was being taught in the classes and I should read these literatures to know more about Jesus. The books that he provided to me are namely 'Life of Christ'; 'Do you know God's Salvation is ready for you?'; 'God is one in the Holy Trinity'; 'Did God appear in the flesh?' etc. I took the books and started reading them.



One day my father saw that I was reading the books. After he read the name of the books, he became really angry. He told me that I should not read these books and told me to throw them immediately. My

mother was also furious and told me that a Muslim should not read these things. I told them about all the teachings and stories were also not from Quran but they were teachings of Jesus Christ from Bible. My parents were

shocked to hear this as they thought that these teachings were from Quran. I pleaded them to read and understand the literature. Because they already knew about the stories and teachings, they agreed with me to read the literatures every day. It took us almost a year to read and understand these books. I also called Bro. Abdul Rashid for assistance and clearing our doubts. After that we all began to believe in Jesus. So, Bro. Abdul Rashid invited us to his church for fellowship. He then encouraged us and took us to attend in various seminars which February 2020

made our faith stronger. So, all of us accepted Jesus Christ as our personal Savior by August 2018. People in our village criticized us once they came to know about our new faith. But we never looked back and all of us took baptism on 18 October 2019. God blessed our family and now our family income is stable as I am also earning money by stitching clothes. Please pray for us so that we could bring our friends and relatives to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ'.



### Thrivent<sup>™</sup> Choice Dollars
