

Mission Minute: AIMJ - Becky All India Misihi Jamat

Two Children's programs were held in February. One taught from Romans 8:1-39 entitled, Be Sure We Are His and the other from Colossians 2:8-15, *What Christ has Done for Us.*

In February AIMJ conducted a total of 13 Baptism Camps and 196 people were baptized! In addition, Seeker's meetings, Women's Meetings, Youth meetings, and Children's meetings were held. In total 365 people attended these meetings.



Mission Minute: Habra Church Building Inauguration

We are so grateful to God for helping AIMJ to complete a church building at Habra, North 24 Parganas, West Bengal. It was inaugurated on 13th Feb. 2021 by AIMJ Chairman, Rev. Sanjoy Kumar Nath and Rev. Depender Sarkar, pastor from CNI church was specially invited.



Also, about 206 of our believers attended the inauguration program. The program started with a reading from Psalms 24: 1-10 by Rev. Sanjoy Kumar Nath with an opening prayer. After this several pastors read several verses from the Bible. Jahirul Islan Sarkar- Phili.- 3:17, 4:1; Azizul Islam- Jer. 25:5-6; Hasan Ali- Psalms 72: 11-19; Mahasin Mondal- Mark 10: 35-45; Wahid Biswas - Romans 13:1-7; Sahadat Gazi- Isaiah- 9: 6-7; Subrat Mondal- 1 Timothy 2:1-6; Jaidul Islam - Psalms 75: 1-7 and Rekha Perveen-John 14:27-31.

The main topic for the message was taken from John 2: 1-10 that Christ turned water into wine as we read in these verses. It was the very first miracle that Jesus did in Cana of Galilee. Just like this we hope and pray that Jesus will change all the Muslims in the community and they will all follow Christ

as their saviour just like how Jesus changed water into wine. It took a lot of time and there were many road blocks ahead of us with the biggest one being COVID-19. But our Lord has been taking care of us and fulfilling all our needs. We praise God that everything went well. Please continue to pray for us so that AIMJ will bring more and more Muslims to Christ so that this building remains not only a church building but God's pillar for the entire community.




