Registration and fellowship time began at 8 am with coffee, juice and light breakfast items. Mission booths that were available included Augustana District, Sola Publishing, Institute of Lutheran Theology, Family Promise, New Hope Mission Society, Inc, Christian Witness Wear, and a Women’s Bible Study Table.

Registration included 70 women from eight Augustana District Churches plus four guest churches in addition to five pastors who attended the gathering.

The average age a human is sold and groomed into sex trade is 13. It is important to educate youth on what to look out for and who to turn to and to provide parents with information who don't believe it could happen to their child. The donations from the service collected for Lacey's Hope Project was \$742

Jacinda Shields spoke on How Churches Can Deepen Their Relationships with Missionaries by giving a missionary's perspective to church missions.

What's in Your Hand based on what God told Moses in Exodus 4:2 – Everyone in attendance was given \$5 to use as seed money for a mission cause.
