Speakers: Pastor Mark Richardson led the church service based on the bible verse from the Order of Baptism, "Let your light so shine before others that they may see good works and glorify your Father in heaven", Matthew 5:16. Offering was \$2046.00 to be divided between Ethiopian Mission, Heartland Girls Ranch and Common Cup. Stoney Point sang during communion.

Pastor Randy Freund gave a brief summary of the Augustana District. There are 78 clergy, 5 more in the process, in 10 states and 65 congregations. Need to develop a presence in the twin cities. Half of the LCMC churches are not currently part of the Augustana District.

Jeannie Thompson from Heartland Girls Ranch in Benson spoke to us about the Ranch and what it does. They take girls from the ages of 12-21. Most have been abused or trafficked. Girls are referred to them by Social Services. They have forty horses that the girls take care of and ride. Their motto is "Healing youth and building lives through success"

Damaris Nyankabaria spoke on her life in Kenya. She now lives in Hutchinson, Minnesota and is currently a nursing student. Her passion is to make a difference to the people she meets.
